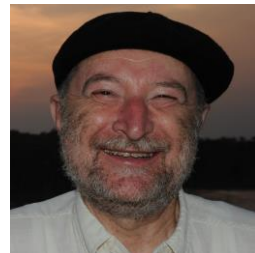

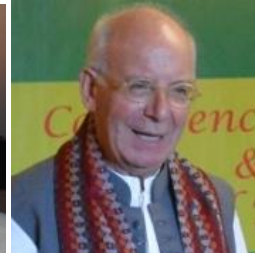

HOST COUNTRY OF THE CONFERENCE - BANGLADESH
