Born in 1945 in the Gopalganj district of Bangladesh, Prof. Dr. M. Feroze Ahmed is an acclaimed Environmental Scientist, outstanding Academician and Writer. He graduated in Civil Engineering from Bangladesh University of Engineering & Technology (BUET) in 1968 and awarded Ph.D. from University of Strathclyde, Glasgow, UK in 1983. He joined BUET in 1969 and became Professor in 1986, where he served as Head, Dean and Hall Provost. Presently, he is the Emeritus Professor of Stamford University Bangladesh, where he was the Vice-Chancellor from 2013 to 2017. Prof. Ahmed has about 160 publications having over 7000 Google Scholar citations. He authored and edited 20 books and proceeding with the contribution in several works related to sanitation, water and sewage sludge treatment. His research work in collaboration with MIT (US) resulted in a breakthrough in understanding the mechanism of arsenic contamination of groundwater. Prof. Ahmed received BUET (Dr. Rashid Memorial) Gold Medal, 1998 in recognition of excellence in teaching and research, Institution of Engineers Bangladesh (IEB) Gold Medal, 2004 for contribution to nation and engineering profession and Bangladesh Academy of Science (Dr. M.O. Ghani Memorial) Gold Medal, 2007 for contribution to advancement of science and technology. He received Asia Education Leadership Award for exceptional leadership quality and achievements.
